### **PRACTICE POLICIES**

The Toronto Argonauts practice at their training facility at the University of Toronto at Mississauga, 3359 Mississauga Rd. N. (between Burnhamthorpe Rd. and Dundas St.). During the regular season work week, Argonauts players are typically available to the media in the locker room for 45 minutes daily. The head coach will also have a designated time for media availability. All media must clear the locker room prior to the meetings. Media are invited to work in the media trailer which has internet access. Additional access to players is available through previously arranged appointments by the Communications department. The Communications staff will provide the weekly practice schedule and locker room availability the day after each game. Practices are open to the media and cameras. Cameras must check in with a Toronto Argonauts Communications staff member to obtain filming/photography restrictions for that practice day.

### **PRE-GAME MEDIA CONFERENCE**

Head Coaches and players from both the Argonauts and the visiting team will be made available to the media at media conferences held the day prior to each Argos' home game. Game notes and CFL statistics will also be made available at this media conference. Details about timing and location of the media conference will be provided by the Toronto Argonauts Communications Department.

### **GAME DAY CREDENTIAL REQUESTS**

Members of the working media who have not been issued season credentials should request single-game credentials in writing at least 48 hours prior to kickoff. Email your request to Beth Waldman, Director, Communications, at [bwaldman@argonauts.ca](mailto:bwaldman@argonauts.ca) or fax to (416) 341-2714. Credentials are not transferable. It is understood that all credentials will be used for the purpose for which they were issued, without exception. Violation of this policy will subject the bearer to ejection from the press box and Rogers Centre.

### **CREDENTIAL DELIVERY**

All game pass credentials should be picked up at the media "will call" desk at Rogers Centre, Gate 13, from three hours before each home kickoff.

### **STADIUM ENTRANCE FOR MEDIA**

The media entrance to Rogers Centre is located at Gate 13, the northwest entrance to the stadium. The Football Media Centre is located beyond the media entrance on Level 300. All members of the media must sign in at the media desk. There are no provisions for media parking.

### **PHOTOGRAPHERS**

Sideline photography in the Canadian Football League is limited to working media on specific assignment for a recognized sports or news publication or news service. No freelance photographers will be accommodated. No one except network television and authorized game



personnel will be admitted to the field without a camera. All field photographers must remain outside the team bench areas and behind the solid line that surrounds the entire perimeter of the playing field, and behind the rotational signage on the home side of the field. Photographers will be able to upload their materials in the photo file room, located in the Players Wives Lounge on field level.

#### LIVE SHOTS

Television stations requiring live shots at either a game or a practice must first receive permission from the Toronto Argonauts Communications department.

#### TELEPHONES/INTERNET CONNECTIONS

Numerous telephone extensions are available throughout the press box. For a designated phone line or hi-speed internet connection at your seat, please contact Nilam Shah at Rogers Centre. Phones for visiting media are provided on a charge-a-call basis. A wireless internet connection is available in the Football Media Centre. The password is available each game at the sign-in desk.

#### MEDIA CENTRE SERVICES

The Toronto Argonauts Media Centre is for the sole use of the working media. Friends and family members of the media are not permitted. An in-house public address announcer keeps the media abreast on play-by play records and game notes.

Statistics & Notes: Game notes from both teams, CFL weekly statistics and depth charts are available at the front table to the media centre. Halftime stats are distributed early in the third quarter and final stats are available on the front table.

#### LOCKER ROOM ACCESS AND POST-GAME INTERVIEWS

Members of the media wishing to conduct post-game interviews in the home or visiting locker rooms will be allowed access after the requisite 'cooling off' period following the conclusion of the game. Access is available to individuals holding valid media credentials. The head coach will conduct a news conference in Meeting Room #2 immediately following the game. All media must gain access to the Argonauts dressing room through MR#2.

## Milestones and record watch/ Faits marquants et records à surveiller

### WHAT TO LOOK FOR IN THE GAME/QUOI SURVEILLER DANS LE MATCH

The Argos and Als tied 34-34 in their only pre-season match up last season. Montreal went on to sweep the Boatmen 3-0-0 in regular season play in 2008. The Argos scored 34 points when these two teams met late in the season, tying for the team's second-highest single game scoring output on the year.

### TEAM/ÉQUIPE

Toronto finished in third place in the East Division in 2008 (4-14-0) but showed offensive outbursts down the stretch. Kerry Joseph is back and has been told to take as many reps as he needs to feel comfortable with the new playbook. This will be the first live CFL game as a coach for six (6) members of Toronto's 2009 coaching staff. Buratto is a long-time CFL veteran coach, and both Kuharchek (B.C. in 1991) and O'Neil (Hamilton in 2007) have previously coached in the CFL.

The Argos will debut several all-star acquisitions from this past off-season. Former CFL Outstanding Lineman OT **Rob Murphy**, OC **Dominic Picard**, CFL All-Star LB **Zeke Moreno** and former second overall CFL draft pick LB **Jason Pottinger** will all be active for the Argonauts for the first time.

There are 10 Argos players from the GTA including: DT **Adriano Belli**, DB **Matt Black**, DB **Delroy Clarke**, LB **Jason Pottinger**, RB **Andre Durie**, RB **Jeff Johnson**, OG **Jeff Keeping**, OG **Richard Zulys**, SB **Andre Talbot**, SB **Mike Bradwell**. In total, there are 15 players on the Argonauts' roster that grew up in Southern Ontario.

## CFL ROOKIES TO WATCH

### OFFENCE

**OL #63 Shannon Boatman** – Has played nearly every position, except centre, on the line throughout camp. The versatile lineman played guard and tackle at Florida State and is the heaviest player on the Argos' roster.

**SB #88 Mike Bradwell** – Injured his hand near the start of camp and he's still practicing hard. He was the Argos' first pick, ninth overall, in the 2008 CFL Draft.

**WR #86 Hank Edwards** – The 6-foot, 3 inch receiver has been putting up a good fight while vying for one of the import receiver positions.

**WR #84 Kenny Higgins** – Having a good camp while demonstrating soft hands and a nose for the ball. He's been putting up a strong fight for a roster spot.

**WR #87 Matt Lambros** – The Argos' second round 2009 draft pick has displayed good hands in training camp and made some eye-popping catches. His father is former Eskimos LB Mike Lambros.

**WR #85 Todd Lowber** – Could be the deep threat the Boatmen have been looking for. The former basketball player with sub-4.2 speed has been catching deep ball after deep ball in practice.

**QB #17 Stephen Reaves** – The son of former All-American and NFL QB John Reaves, the southpaw earned the Argos' third quarterback spot out of mini-camp. He's demonstrated a strong/accurate arm throughout camp.

**WR #89 Cleannord Saintil** – Another import receiver that has had a good camp and rotated in and out of the starting line-up.

### DEFENCE

**LB #44 Derrick Ballard** – Played two seasons for Bart Andrus and the Amsterdam Admirals.

**DB #39 Matt Black** – The speedy Toronto-native has done everything asked in training camp including punt returns. If he's on the field, then you'll no doubt find him near the play.

**CB #24 Dovonte Edwards** – Has had a strong camp while subbing in for the starters whenever possible.

**DS #43 James Green** – An aggressive player who has been taking a lot of reps at safety. He was the Argos' third round pick in the 2009 draft.

**LB #41 Nick Hannah** – A quiet player who always seems to be around the ball. Nick played for coach Andrus in Amsterdam and even played a few games with the B.C. Lions last season.

**CB #36 Alphonso Hodge** – A team-player who flies around the field. He arrived in Toronto from the AFL.

**DE #91 Ben Ishola** – Has been taking a lot of reps at defensive end. He was a training camp body for the Alouettes in 2008.

**DB #38 Sammy Joseph** – A good competitor who has been diligent on defence all camp. He's made a few big plays to keep the offence aware.



**DT #93 Étienne Légaré** – Along with fellow NIP defensive lineman Adrian Davis, the second overall pick in the 2009 CFL Draft has received a significant number of reps in camp – thanks mainly to Belli’s nagging pelvic injury.

**DB #21 Lin-J Shell** – The animated DB has been turing heads with his strong play in training camp.

**#13 K/P Eddie Johnson** – The import kicker arrived in camp with a superior punting leg. He has since improved his place kicking ability and narrowly missed a 57-yard attempt in practice last week.

**#7 K/P Justin Medlock** – The former UCLA star has shown a sound place kicking leg while working to improve his punting ability. He has come along nicely in training camp and with more practice could be capable of doing both.

## COACHES

**Steve Buratto (1994-95)** – Buratto was the mastermind behind one of the most powerful offences in CFL history while winning a Grey Cup with the Baltimore Stallions in 1995. The Stallions, of course, moved to Montreal in 1996 and became the Alouettes. The 1994 season was the only other season (besides 2007 and 2008) that Buratto has coached in the East Division.

**Miles Gorrell (1982-85)** – Gorrell played four seasons in Montreal and was among the distinguished alumni honoured during the Als' 2007 home pre-season game.

**Pete Kuharchek (2007)** - Invited as a guest coach to the Alouettes' 2007 training camp.

## PLAYERS

**NT Adriano Belli (2001-03, 06)** – Played 37 games for the Alouettes and amassed 34 DT, 6 sacks and 8 tackles for a loss. He also played in three Grey Cup championships with the Als.

**OG Jeff Keeping (2007)** – Left the Argos to sign with the Alouettes after the 2006 season and spent the entire year on Montreal's injured list.

**DE Ben Ishola (2008)** – Attended 2007 training camp with Montreal.

**WR Brad Smith (2007)** – Drafted by the Argonauts in 2007 and played one game before being claimed off Toronto's practice roster by Montreal mid-way through the season. He played seven games in Montreal.

**OL Chris Van Zeyl (2008)** – Drafted by Montreal in the third round, 18<sup>th</sup> overall, in the 2007 CFL Draft, he attended 2 training camps with the Als before coming to Toronto.

## OTHER

**LB Jean-Nicolas Carriere** – A product of McGill University, Carriere was the Argos' third round selection in the 2009 CFL Draft. He lived across the street from Percival Molson Stadium while at school and says he used it as motivation to get himself to the pros.

**WR Obed Cétoute** – Grew up in Montreal before attending school at Central Michigan.

**DL Adrian Davis** – Attended Marshall University before transferring to Concordia in Quebec. Drafted in the 4<sup>th</sup> round of the 2006 CFL Draft by Montreal and released following 2007 training camp.

**DT Étienne Légaré** – Grew up in Saint-Raymond, Quebec a small community outside Quebec City, and attended Laval University.

**OC Dominic Picard** – Grew up in Saint-Foy, Quebec, a suburb of Quebec City, and attended Laval University.
